4. Discussion and Action items:

- 1. Quiet Zone Update  
 Aaron Lincoln spoke regarding the current progress. The intersection is to be open late Thursday night. The railroad will then have 60 days to become a quiet zone.
- 2. Recommendations for Warrior Road's New Island  
 Aaron talked about the median at Warrior Road with regards on how to beautify that area. Community Action Team has talked about donating funds to help, per Corey Buss. The group will present ideas at the next meeting.
- 3. Discussion Regarding Roundtable Rd/Windsor Way and 1st Street Intersection  
 Aaron noted that the City has discussed the removal of the stop sign at this intersection and adding a lighted crosswalk intersection. This goes along with the next agenda item with the Safe Routes to School sidewalk additions. The committee discussed the pros and cons of removing vs keeping the stop signs. Traffic does not justify the stop sign especially with the addition of the sidewalk along first street from Vandenberg intersection to Windsor Way. The group agrees that with the addition of the sidewalk the stop signs may not be necessary.
